| 2. (B) Replace 'yours' with 'your'.  | 11. (C) Replace 'I am not having time' with 'I do not have time.' Sentence should be in Present Indefinite Tense.  |
| 3. (B) Replace 'yourself' with 'yourselves'. 'Among' in the sentence indicates that there are more than two persons. Hence 'Plural' form of 'yourself' will be used. | 12. (B) Replace 'disposed off' with 'disposed of' which means 'to finish with' or 'to get rid of'.   |
| 4. (C) Replace 'Prior of' with 'Prior to'. Prior takes preposition 'to' which means 'existing earlier in time'.  | 13. (C) Replace 'keep' with 'keeps'. Verb should be used according to the subject before preposition. Here 'a ray' is singular.  |
| 5. (D) No error  | 14. (C) Replace 'goes' with 'go'. Hence 'Poverty' and 'development' are two different things. Hence together it will be 'Plural'.  |
