- (B) Replace 'which branches' with 'the branches of which'. Formation of sentence is important here.
- (C) Replace 'their' with 'its'. For a party (singular subject) possessive adjective 'its' is used.
- (A) Replace 'dress in black' with 'dressed in black'. Here 'dressed' will be used to define the students who were dressed in black.
- (D) No error
 - Out-of-door (Adj.) : Located, suited for or taking place in the open air.
- (B) Replace 'have shaped' into 'shaped'. According to the meaning, of the sentence, the sentence should be in Past Indefinite Tense.
- (C) Replace 'is' with 'was'. Sentence is in Past Tense.
- (C) Replace 'so frail' with 'too frail'. 'So' must be followed by 'that'. For undesirable things 'too' must be used.
- (C) Replace 'fairly ordinary' with 'rather ordinary'. 'Fairly' is used with desirable adjectives while rather is used with undesirable adjective.
- (C) Replace 'sooner' with 'soon'. 'Sooner' is used when there is a comparison.
