- 3. (A) If a sentence starts with 'It' followed by any form of 'be', the pronoun that follows 'be' must be in nominative case, and the verb that comes after shall follow it.
- 4. (B) V3 of 'slay' is 'slain'. 'slay' means 'to kill'.
- 5. (A) 'Describe' doesn't take any preposition.
- 6. (B) Comparative degree of 'strong' is 'stronger'.
- 7. (B) 'Avail' takes a reflexive pronoun.
- 3. (C) When there is comparison between two things, we should use comparative degree.
- 9. (B) Here 'rise' a singular subject will take singular verb 'has'.
- 10. (C) The sentence has started with past verb 'were' and hence will proceed in past.
- 12. (C) Reason same as 10.

- 13. (B) 'Debar' takes 'from' and 'V + ing' after it.
- 14. (B) Change 'Play' into 'Playing'.
- 15. (A) Change 'is' into 'has been'. The tense of the sentence must be perfect continuous as 'since + time' is given in the sentence.
- 16. (B) Add 'other' after 'all the'. If 'one' is compared with 'other of the same group', we need to use word 'other' to exclude the 'one' that belongs to the same group.
- 17. (B) Change 'are' into 'is'. 'The only good thing' which is a singular subject. Hence will take singular verb.
- 18. (C) Change 'left' into 'leaves'. The sentence is of future conditional.
- 19. (A) Change 'were' into 'was'. Collective noun takes singular verb if it is unanimous.



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- 20. (A) Change 'was she' into 'she was' as the sentence is affirmative. 21. (B) Change 'will' into 'would' as reporting verb is in past. Hence, the reported speech shall be in Past tense too.
- 21. (B) Here 'would be moving' be used, as in indirect speech 'would' is used in place of 'will'.
- 22. (B) Replace 'in' by 'into', as it shows movement.
- 23. (C) Change 'have' into 'has' as the subject (i.e. each of the student) is singular.
- 24. (C) Change 'centuries' into 'century'.
- 25. (B) Change 'to go' into 'going' as we need a subject after possessive adjective 'her'.
- 26. (A) The sentence is in past tense, change 'saves' into 'saved'.
- 27. (A) Change 'adviced' into 'advised'. 'Advice' is a noun, whereas 'advise' is a verb.
- 28. (A) Change 'canon' into 'cannons' which refers to old type of large heavy guns carried on wheels.
- 29. (A) Same as Q. NO. (21).

- 30. (B) Change 'shed' into 'shedding'. 'shed tears' means 'to cry'.
- 31. (C) Change 'were' into 'was', as it shall follow. The subject 'the group', which is singular.
- 32. (C) Change 'were' into 'was', as it should agree with the nearest subject.
- 33. (B) Change 'has' into 'had' as the sentence is in past tense.
- 34. (C) Change 'to dance' into 'dance or dancing'.

 Two things being compared should be in same form.
- 35. (A) Remove 'are'.
- 37. (B) 'Neither of + plural Nouns' is singular and hence followed by singular verb. Change 'are' into 'is'.
- 38. (A) Change 'thinking' into 'having thought', as 'think' doesn't take continous form usually.
- 39. (B) Change 'follow' into 'follows', as it should follow the subject (i.e. man) which is singular.
- 40. (B) In case of comparison, comparative degree is used. Change 'worst' into 'worse'.
