> Tianhe-1is a supercomputer capable of maximum range of 2.5 peta FLOPS. Located at the National Supercomputing Center in Tianjin, China, it was the fastest computer in the world from October 2010 to June 2011 and is one of the few Peta scale supercomputers in the world.


According to the Article 165, he is appointed by the Governor and holds office during the pleasure of the Governor. Only a person qualified to be a judge of High Court can be appointed to the post.




